### ----- Conference Themes -----

The conference wants to address the issues of overcoming global threats and developing inter-cultural dialogue, including religious tolerance and inter-faith dialogue, exploring stability and developing mutual cooperation. The theme of global threats includes an analysis and ideas for the solution of various cultural, religious, military and other conflicts. The theme is connected with issues of peace, nonviolence, mutual cooperation, etc. The theme of inter-cultural dialogue contains a debate between European secular cultural and religious perspectives, on the one side, and Islamic religious and cultural perspectives, on the other. It is closely connected to issues of tolerance between various cultural and religious points of view. The theme of stability is linked to the topics of plurality of public models, participation of citizens, democracy, rights, and the rule of law.

The conference will be attended by Czech and foreign human and social scientists, the ambassadors of countries of the European Union and the Muslim countries, special guests, and journalists.
